LIVE WORKING – GUIDELINES FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE PLANS

ULC is pleased to announce the publication of the First Edition of CAN/ULC 61318-03 (CEI/IEC 61318:1994, IDT), Live Working – Guidelines for Quality Assurance Plans. This Standard has been approved by the ULC Committee on Live Working, and has been published under the date of October 2003.

This National Standard of Canada is an adoption, without modification of the Technical Report published by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) with the designation, CEI/IEC 61318:1994. This document is to be considered as guideline information and is not intended for regulatory or conformity assessment purposes.

This Technical Report establishes the guidelines for the plans and procedures assuring the quality of tools and equipment used for live working on electrical installations.


The report incorporates the concept of quality assurance based on the ISO 9000 series and also integrates a single sampling plan and procedure using normal inspection and special inspection levels based on IEC 410.
