### First Edition of ULC-S646-98 (including Amendment 1)

### Standard for Exhaust Hoods and Related Controls for Commercial and Institutional Kitchens

ULC is pleased to announce the release of Amendment 1 to the First Edition of ULC-S646-98, Standard for Exhaust Hoods and Related Controls for Commercial and Institutional Kitchens. Amendment 1 has been approved by the ULC Committee on Kitchen Exhaust Equipment and Systems, and has been published under the date of April 2004, while the First Edition of this Standard was published in January 1998.


ULC-S646-98 will be of interest to anyone who operates or specifies commercial or institutional kitchens. This Standard covers exhaust hoods for commercial and institutional kitchens and are intended for placement over restaurant-type cooking equipment, such as ranges, broilers, deep-fat fryers, grills, etc. Exhaust hoods covered by these requirements are intended for installation in accordance with the Standard for Ventilation Control and Fire Protection of Commercial Cooking Operations, NFPA 96. These requirements cover equipment rated not over 600 V and intended for installation under the requirements of the Canadian Electrical Code, Part I.

Amendment 1 contains revisions to Clauses 3.1.1, 3.2.1 and 4.1.1, and additional clause numbers 3.7.6 and 6.5. These revisions cover Construction Assembly and Materials, and general Compliance. This Standard is now being re-published to contain the First Edition of ULC-S646-98, as well as Amendment 1, and all users are advised to obtain this complete version.
