Fourth Edition of CAN/ULC-S602-03 Including Amendments 1 & 2

ABOVEGROUND STEEL TANKS FOR THE STORAGE OF COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS INTENDED TO BE USED AS HEATING AND/OR GENERATOR FUELS

ULC is pleased to announce the publication of Amendments 1 & 2 to CAN/ULC-S602-03, Aboveground Steel Tanks for the Storage of Combustible Liquids Intended to be used as Heating and/or Generator Fuels. These Amendments have been approved by the ULC Committee on Stationary Steel Storage Containers for Flammable and Combustible Liquids and have been published under the date of May 2005.

Amendment 1 seeks to explain the requirements under the Marking Section. The revisions specify alternate methods of marking and labeling and a more appropriate letter size for the marking. Amendment 2 clarifies the venting requirements under Subsection 4.3.1, Closed Secondary Containment, to make it consistent with Figure 6.

Further information shall be released shortly by ULC's Conformity Assessment group regarding the application of these Amendments and the effective date for any new requirements.
