Thank you for your letter of December 13, 2011 regarding your company's name change from Underwriters Laboratories, Inc. to UL, LLC. This letter is being sent to recognize that our records have been updated to reflect the change. All other information contained below remains the same as the notice our office issued on November 21, 2011.

This will provide documentation that the WV Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR) Office of Environmental Health Services (OEHS) recognizes the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection certification (#E87775) and approval as a NELAP accredited laboratory for radionuclide identification and radiochemistry analysis of samples using methods for compliance with NELAC standards (required by the SDWA and CWA) at the address above. The analytical methods for radioactivity, in accordance with applicable parts of 40CFR* and Title 64 of the WV Code of State Rules (64CSR03.13.5) or further analysis with referrals, should include capability for MCL of gross alpha, gross beta, radium-226, radium-228, tritium (H-3), strontium-89, strontium-90, uranium 238/235 and radon-222 water quality analysis. This certification expires concurrently with the PA DEP certification on **June 30, 2012**. Please send any updated out-of-state certification documents with your request for renewal of this notice.

The DHHR Office of Laboratory Services and OEHS Environmental Engineering Division will maintain a copy of this notice for their files.
