

# **CB SCHEME Services Requirement Overview**

**1. Scope of Service** - UL will evaluate Client's products and issue a CB Test Certificate and associated CB Test Report in accordance with applicable technical requirements and according to the CB Scheme program requirements, Rules of Procedure of the Scheme of the IECEE ("Rules") for Recognition of Results of Testing to Standards for Safety of Electrical Equipment ("CB Scheme") – IECEE Publication 02). The services requested by Client and to be provided by UL for specific projects shall be set out in individual Applications.

## **2. Eligibility of a Product for CB Test Certificate**

2.1 A product investigation involves the performance of tests and the examination of product construction to determine compliance with applicable technical requirements (IEC standards). Client agrees to supply all information needed for evaluation of product(s).

2.2 The issuance of the CB Test Certificate is subject to: (i) investigation of the product according to the applicable technical requirements (IEC standards); (ii) the product's compliance with the applicable technical requirements (IEC standards); and (iii) the manufacturer's compliance with the current Rules of Procedure and Operational Documents of the CB Scheme, which may be revised from time to time. To the extent it is applicable, the most current edition of IECEE 02 and Operational Documents are incorporated herein by reference and made fully a part hereof, except when otherwise modified or supplemented by this Agreement. If Manufacturer does not have a copy of the most current editions of IECEE 02 and the Operational Documents, Manufacturer may obtain the Rules of Procedure directly from the IECEE (<http://www.iecee.org/cbscheme/default.htm>). The applicable Operational Documents may be obtained from the NCB.

**3. Cost of Investigation** - UL's Quotation will establish the price for UL's Services. UL's Quotation will depend upon the type of product and the test requirements. UL's Quotation is subject to change at UL's discretion, upon reasonable notice to the Client, due to any additional project specific requirements or scope changes.

**4. Estimated Schedule** - Client recognizes that each product investigation is unique and that the timing of each investigation will vary depending upon the particular investigation and its findings. If appropriate, UL will provide Client with an estimated time schedule in the Quotation for Product investigation.

## **5. Compliance with the IECEE CB Scheme Requirements**

5.1 If UL determines that a Product submitted is in compliance with all applicable technical requirements, including CB Scheme Program Requirements, UL will issue a CB Test Certificate and associated CB Test Report. The Client agrees that the products for which the CB Test Certificate has been issued will comply with the applicable technical requirements, including CB Scheme program requirements, at all times.

5.2 The Client agrees that the CB Test Certificates shall not be used in any form of advertising or sales promotion.

NOTE: This requirement does not preclude the holder of a CB Test Certificate from making reference to the existence of that Certificate in business correspondence related to equipment for which a CB Test Certificate has been issued.

5.3 Manufacturer shall promptly notify NCB of any changes in the product construction, which may be material to NCB's issuance of the CB Test Certificate and associated CB Test Report.

5.4 The IEC, IECEE and combination IEC/IECEE logos are copyrighted and belong to the IEC. Their use is restricted to official documents published by the IEC or the IECEE or both and shall not be reproduced or utilized by the manufacturer in any form or by any means, electronic or mechanical, including photocopying and microfilm, without prior permission in writing from the IECEE Secretary.

5.5 The NCB reserves the right to withdraw the CB Test Certificate if, in the sole opinion of the NCB, the Manufacturer obstructs in any way the aim, operation or development of the CB Scheme, fails to take action regarding misuse of CB Test Certificates or otherwise violates the Rules,

**6. Use of UL's Name and Marks** - CB Scheme investigation and CB Scheme Test Certificate shall not result in UL product safety certification or any authorization to use the UL Mark. Unless additionally evaluated and explicitly authorized by UL, Client shall not use UL's name, abbreviation, or symbols, or any other form of reference which may be interpreted to mean Underwriters Laboratories Inc., its subsidiaries or affiliates, on any goods or their containers or packaging, or in connection with any oral or written advertising, promotions, or otherwise. A product must meet UL's safety certification requirements and be covered by UL's Follow-Up Service to bear UL's registered certification marks – including the “UL in a circle.”
