UL is updating our Data Acceptance Program (DAP) policies and documentation due to the updated U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Directive CPL-01-00-004. This directive includes new requirements that must be addressed by the management systems of all Client Test Data Program and Third Party Test Data Program participant laboratories.

Our DAP assessors have already been introducing these new requirements during this year's annual assessments, and will continue partnering with you to answer questions and help you implement the new requirements.
