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Why Create a MyHome Account?



- MyHome is where you will <u>access ULwebCerts</u>
- Why is ULwebCerts important?
 - It provides a unique set of tools specifically designed to assist with compliance management
 - With ULwebCerts, you can:
 - Retrieve a copy of your Certificate of Compliance at anytime
 - Issue certificates online
 - Generate reports online
 - InvoiceAnalysis
 - Certificate Inventory Reports (Monitoring and Issuing)
 - Certificate of Compliance

Step 1: Register for a MyHome Account



- Begin by opening Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox
 - MyHome is only compatible with Mozilla Firefox or Internet Explorer(the most updated version)

Navigate to my.home.ul.com and click on 'Register Now'

- Enter nine-digit subscriber number in box. Subscriber number can be found on the Authorization Page of UL Follow-Up Service Procedure, on Contracts and Agreements signed with UL and on Multiple Listing Correlation Sheets.
- Click Make Request. Your company's gatekeeper will be alerted and will respond to your request.

Need to establish a gatekeeper for your company's subscriber records? -> Help -> Quick Tips -> Gatekeeper -> Establish a Gatekeeper

NOTE 1: Accounts are NOT Transferable from one person to another *NOTE 2: Accounts must be accessed at least once per year to remain active* NOTE 3: First / Last Names and eMail address cannot be changed without UL validation
